

S.B. BOSS GIVES DAD

SYMPATHY AND SWEETS

JOHANNESBURG'S security police chief, Colonel Greying, offered Mr. Yusuf Timol — father of Ahmed Timol who fell 120 ft. from the 10th floor of John Vorster Square while being detained for questioning — sweets and sympathy when the two met in the Colonel's office on Thursday morning.

Mr. Timol and his lawyer Mr. M. Cachalla had called on Col. Greying to make preliminary arrangements of Ahmed's funeral.

Mr. Timol refused the sweets because he is fasting — it is the Muslim month of Ramadan. Col. Greying discussed the meaning of Ramadan briefly with him.

He also expressed his sincere condolences, according to Mr. Cachalla.

A post-mortem examination will be performed on Ahmed Timol's body tomorrow morning and police have raised no objection to a pathologist representing the Timol family being present.

The Timol lawyers have approached the Commissioner of Police with a view to obtaining permission for another son, Mohamed, to attend the funeral which will be held after the post-mortem tomorrow.

Two SB Raids

The mother of the dead detainee told POST that SB cops twice raided their home — the first time when they arrested Ahmed, the second 24 hours before his death plunge.

Mrs. Hawabibi Timol, 52, said her son, an English teacher at Rodepoort High School, was detained early on Saturday morning.

On Tuesday they again visited the home for a further search.

Three cops came on Tuesday and told Mrs. Timol they had been sent by her son to fetch one of his school books. While searching the house, Mrs. Timol said she pleaded with them and asked them whether she could see her son.

On Wednesday evening another three SB cops called and told her her son had committed suicide.

Refused

Mr. Yusuf Timol, the dead man's father, was at the mosque. "I asked them to wait for my husband, but they refused and left."

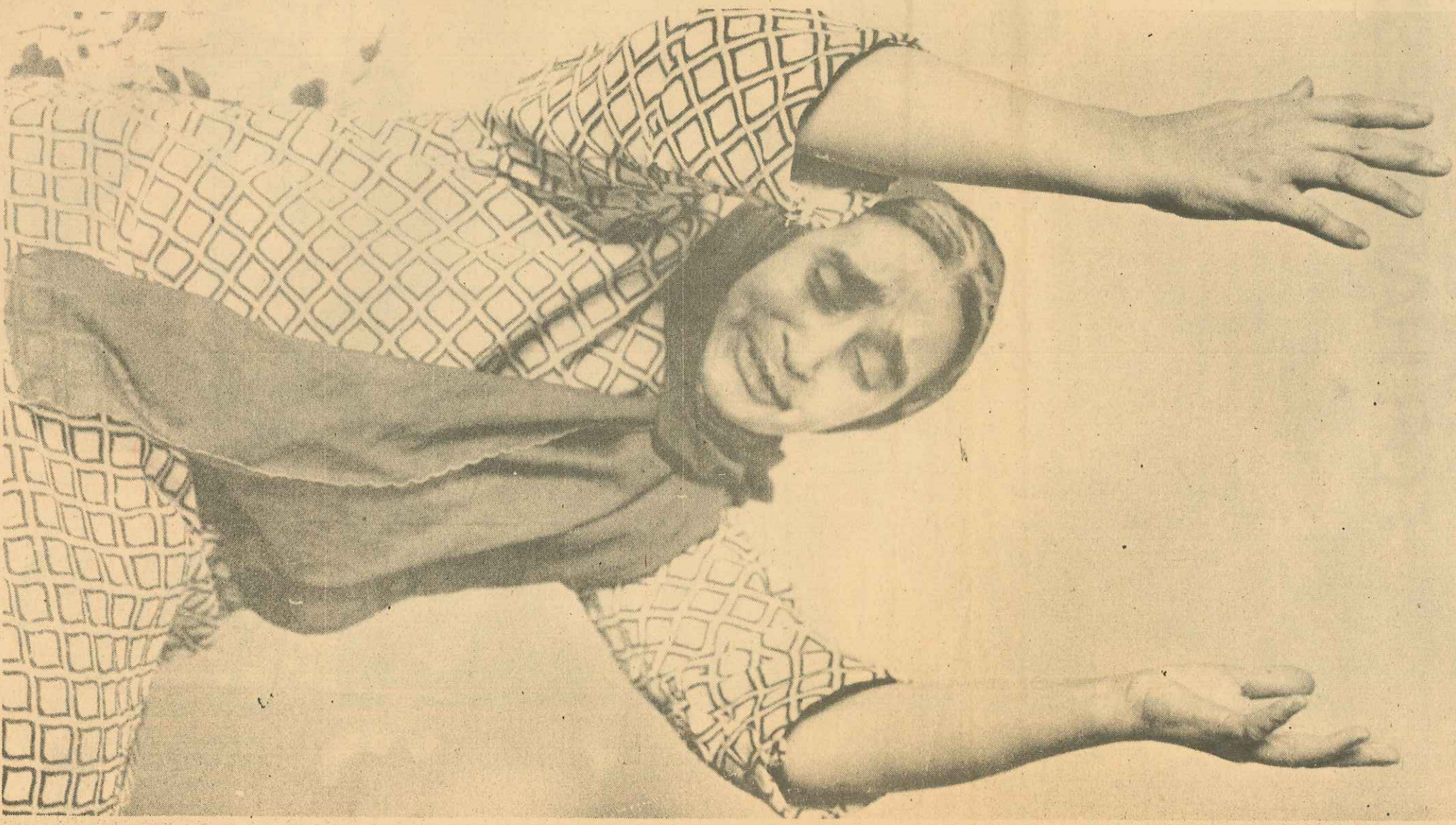
