# TIMOL'S MEMORY TO BE HONoured

TODAY October 27 marks the third anniversary of the death in detention of Roodepoort school teacher Mr Ahmed Timol.

The Human Rights Committee, a body formed in support of the movement for a society free of discrimination based on colour, class, belief or sex, this week issued a reminder to the people of South Africa to remember that day.
