

Police hold another man

MR. DENNIS NAIK, 25, a young Indian upholsterer from Rodepoort, was detained by the Security Police at his home early yesterday.

He is the cousin of Mr. K. C. Naik, a schoolteacher, who has been detained under the Terrorism Act since October 25.

It is not yet known whether Mr. Dennis Naik is being detained under the Act or not.

To date, 19 people — including 15 Indians — are still being held in Johannesburg, Durban and Pretoria under the Terrorism Act.

Mr. C. M. Naik said his son was arrested at 5.30 am yesterday. Plainclothes police searched the home in terms of a warrant but removed nothing.

He said Dennis was the eldest of his seven sons and one daughter.

A senior police officer in Pretoria yesterday confirmed that detainees arrested in recent Security Police raids and found to be in possession of drugs were not arrested under the Terrorism Act for possessing drugs.
