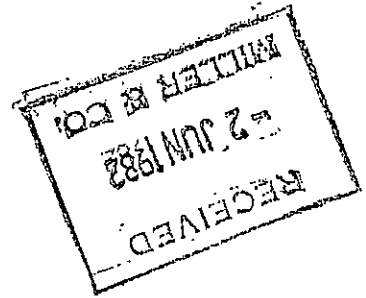

Dear Sirs,

re: THE LATE DR. NEIL AGGETT

We refer to your letter of the 10th May 1982 and wish to acknowledge receipt at our Bank of the sum of R1915.13.

The inquest into the death of Dr. Aggett is due to reconvene in the Magistrate's Court on the 1st June 1982. At the last hearing, one of the persons who was attending in the Public Gallery was taken by members of the Security Police and served with a "Banning Order". This order restricts him from attending all gatherings, being quoted by any publication, being associated with any publication, from working in certain places; from leaving the magisterial district of Johannesburg and he is required to report to a police station once a week. The person on whom this Banning Order was served was an ex-detainee, Mr. Morris Smithers. It appears that one of the reasons for the banning of Mr. Smithers may well have been that the authorities wish to prevent him being quoted in our newspapers.

In fact, Mr. Smithers was the detainee who smuggled the note out to myself relating to the maltreatment in John Vorster Square of Dr. Neil Aggett. He will be giving evidence at the inquest relating to what he saw. I have had several consultations with him and with the Attorneys and Advocates who are acting for the Aggett family and we believe that Mr. Smithers' evidence is extremely important and that he has shown great courage in trying to make known what he saw even while he was in detention.

The firm of Attorneys with whom I was previously employed, Andrew and Lister Incorporated, prepared a Statement of Account in respect of work done while Mr. Smithers was a detainee. These fees came to the total sum of R172.00 This is in respect of work done from the time of first detention in September 1981 until the end of March 1982 when I terminated my association with that firm. I am deducting this sum of R172.00 from the monies sent by you and which are presently being held in our Trust account.


