
AFFIDAVIT OF SARAH BIBI LALL

I, the undersigned

SARAH BIBI LALL

do hereby make oath and state that:

- 1 I am an adult female with identity number 440930 0075 081, residing in Pietermaritzburg, Kwa Zulu Natal.
- 2 Unless the context indicates otherwise, the facts contained in this affidavit are within my personal knowledge and are, to the best of my belief, both true and correct.
- 3 Towards the end of the year 2017, I was approached by a prosecutor, Advocate Shubnum Singh from the National Prosecuting Authority who was making enquiries about the death of my brother, Doctor Hoosen Mia Haffejee who died in police detention in 1977.
- 4 I handed over all the documentation that I had in my possession which included but was not limited to the copies of the post mortem reports, media articles, newspaper clippings, photographs and other documents pertaining to my late brother Doctor Haffejee.
- 5 These articles were kept in a black briefcase which my late elder brother Yusuf had diligently collated and collected during the remaining years of his life. He became

obsessed with finding out what happened to his brother. No one had access to it other than Yusuf. He jealously guarded it and allowed no one access to it. When Yusuf passed away in 2009, I took possession of the bag with the contents thereof. It stayed in my possession. No one else had access to it. During the time it was in my custody, I did not interfere or tamper with it in any way.

- 6 On 23 January 2018, Advocate Singh and Warrant officer F Kgamanyane visited at my home in Pietermaritzburg again, to update me about the investigation. I handed over a copy of an aerogram letter which I found in a book in a bookshelf in Yusuf's room, dated 20th May 1977, addressed to one Jurgen from one Mathee. It was found about a week ago when I was cleaning the bookshelf. I can only think that it might have been my brother Yusuf who could have put it in the book because he did not want my mother to see the content thereof. The bookshelf was Yusuf's. It was in his room.
- 7 I also found a brown envelope with three photographs in it. The brown envelope is addressed "SA National Council for the blind, Private Bag X44, Hatfield, 0028." Across it is written "Essop". Of the three photographs, one is a copy of the original. It depicts a white man who appears to be in camouflage uniform. The original has the following depicted at the back: <DSCN3779.JPG> A00615-004 0003 NNN1 3. The other photograph appears to be that of an image of a police cell, door and window. The following is depicted at the back of the photograph. <DSCN3779.JPG> A00615-004 0003 NNN1 3. I handed them over to Warrant Officer Kgamanyane.
- 8 During the time period that I discovered the letter and the photographs, only I had access to them. I did not interfere or tamper with them in any way.
