 informed me that chief Lotuli had passed away.
 We then went to the Bridge where the train had
 ran over him.

On our arrival there Mr chief Albert Lotuli had
 already been removed and we cleaned the blood
 that was there on the railway. No one was
 around. We went there with Mr Mabaso because he
 had seen the accident. There were no houses
 around the scene to railway, so we couldn't get
 any information as to what have happened, even the
 train that killed the chief had already gone, we
 didn't see or know the driver of the train and there
 were no witnesses present

I also wish to state that Mr Mabaso had also
 passed away.
